## **Political History**

Ciro Gomes was born into a family with a long history of involvement in Brazilian politics, and is himself a career politician and lawyer. At the age of 24, he began his political career as a state deputy in Ceará with the Democratic Social Party (PDS). In 1989, he became the mayor of Fortaleza, Ceará's In 1990, capital. Ciro was elected state **governor** running as a candidate of the Social Democracy Party (PSDB). During his terms as mayor and as governor, he was considered one of the most popular leaders in Brazil, according to a number of surveys by Datafolha and Ibope.

In 1994, Ciro was appointed to be the **economic minister** by then-President Itamar Franco. Ciro **ran for president** in **1998** and **2002**, finishing **third and fourth** respectively. Subsequent to these presidential bids, he was the **Minister of the Department of National Integration** during Lula's administration in 2003. Later, he served as a **federal deputy**, starting in 2006. In 2015, Ciro became affiliated with the Democratic Labor Party (PDT).
