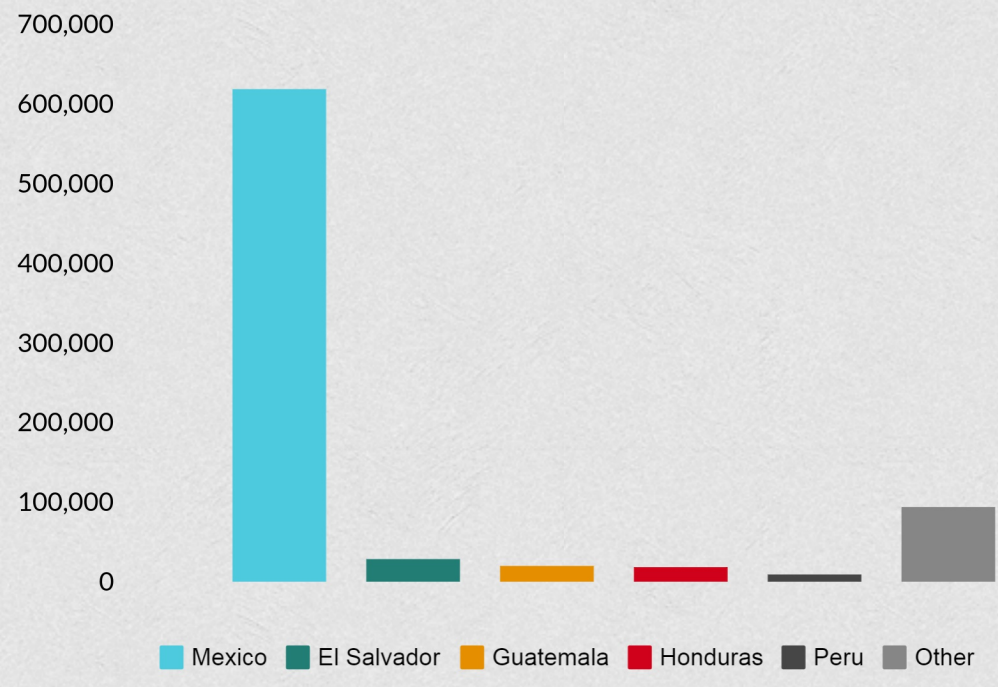


On September 5, 2017, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security rescinded the June 15, 2012 DHS Memorandum: "Exercising Prosecutorial Discretion with Respect to Individuals Who Came to the United States as Children." This ended the five year policy known as DACA established by the Obama administration to allow young immigrants without lawful status to receive a renewable two year reprieve from removal, work authorization, and participation in the Social Security Program. The USCIS is no longer accepting new requests and it will only accept renewals until October for those expiring in the next six months.

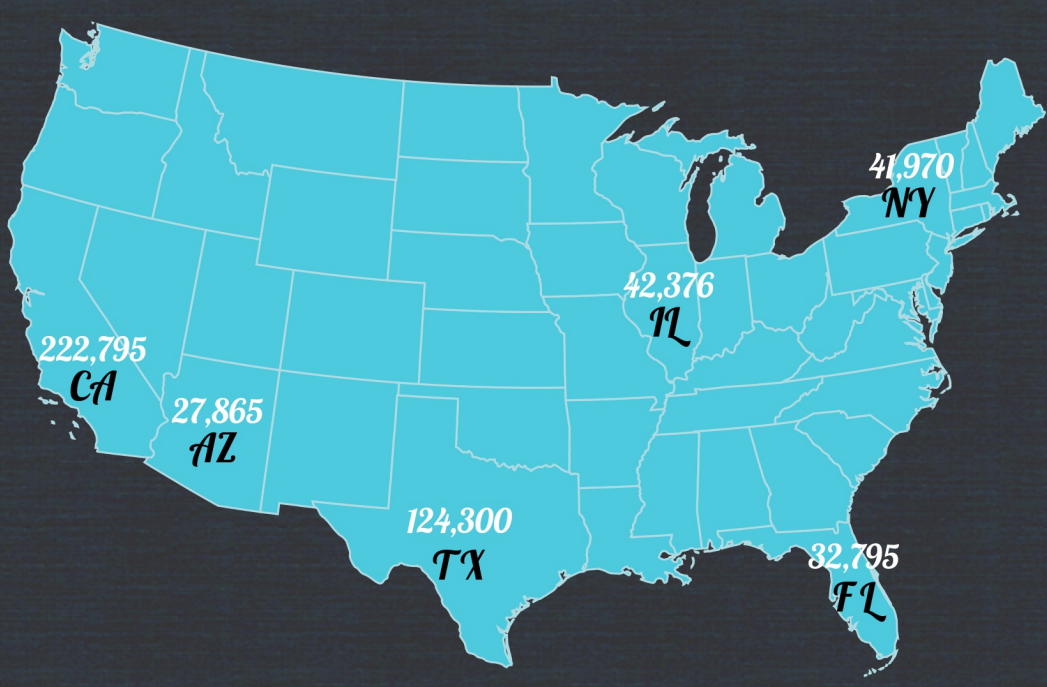
Who are the **DACA** recipients?
