





DR Congolese refugee population

DRC Repatriation Jan – 7 November 2007

- 22 convoys/repatriation ships to Katanga (Moba/Pweto/Kalemie)
- 58 repatriation ships to South Kivu (Baraka/Fizi)
- 102 repatriation boats to Equateur (Kungu/Dongo, Imese, Buburu)
- Voluntary refugee return to Rwanda by road continues (5,820 returnees)





- axis Imese extreme remote return areas
- Assisted return to Katanga started in April 2007 - currently Moba on hold due to incident, Kalemie has restarted on 11 October
