Enhanced Military Cooperation Agreement

- Signed by U.S. Secretary of State and Canadian Minister of Foreign Affairs in Dec 2002
 - Extended to 12 May 2006
- Affirms merit of broadening bi-national defence arrangements to:
 - Prevent or mitigate threats or attacks by terrorists or others;
 - Ensure cooperative, well-coordinated response to national requests for military assistance in relation to terrorist or other threats or attacks, natural disasters and other major emergencies in Canada or the U.S.



- Find opportunities for improvement
- Facilitate enhanced military cooperation
- Examine areas from strategic to tactical levels
- Emphasis on information sharing
- Staff concepts with key stakeholders for input
 - Attempt to reach consensus
 - Communication is the key
- Present concepts to decision makers
 - Identify the best relationship(s) possible

 - Civilian PSEPC, DHS





- All interdependent





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






Information Sharing

- Foreign disclosure waiver






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

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

 - Government to government circuit





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

Four Concepts




Missions clearly defined and delineated between all three commands





CONCEPT 1: THREE COMMANDS – COMPLEMENTARY MISSIONS




CONCEPT 2 - SINGLE COMMAND FOR CONTINENTAL DEFENSE
