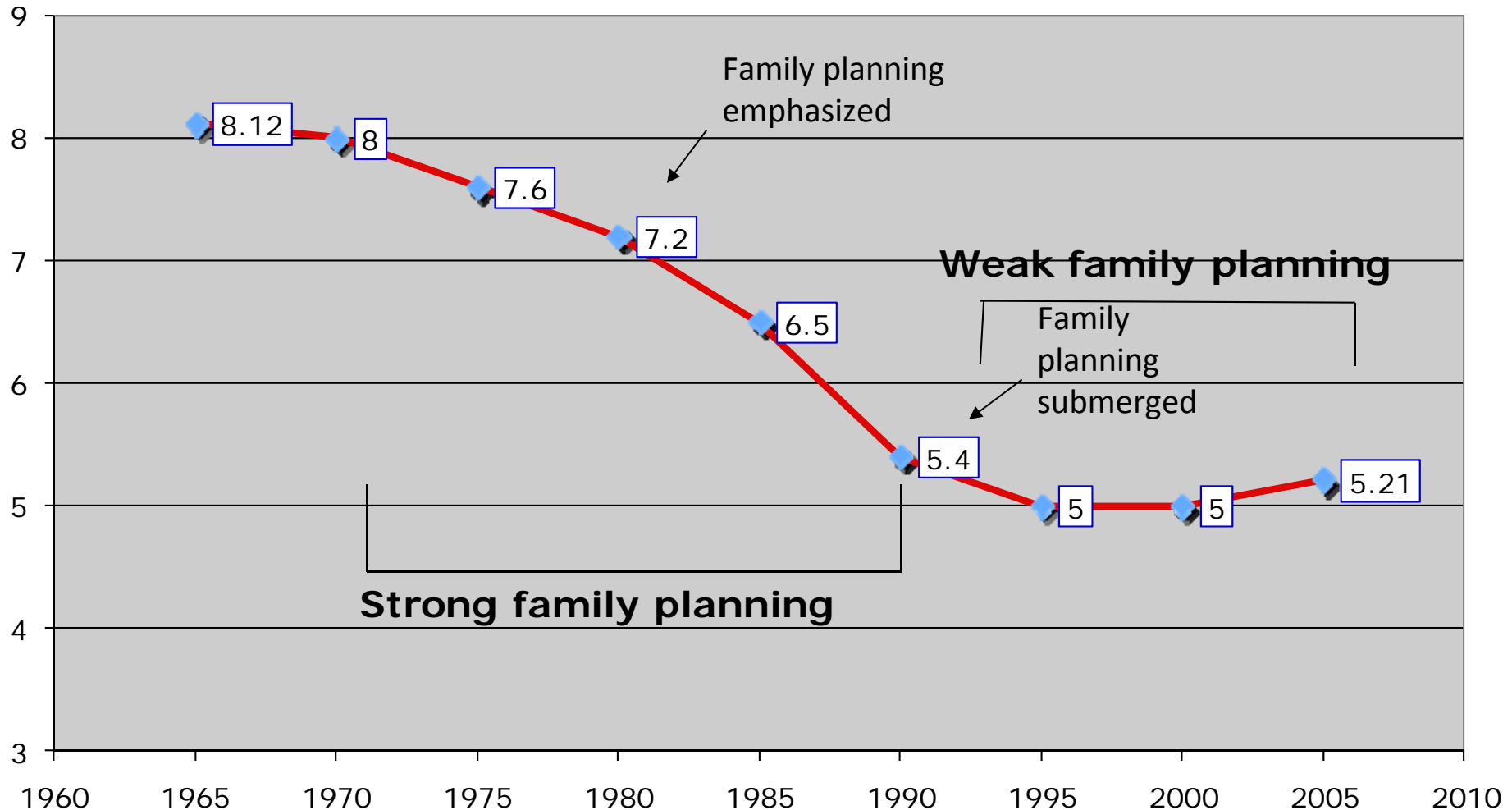


Why the silence on population?

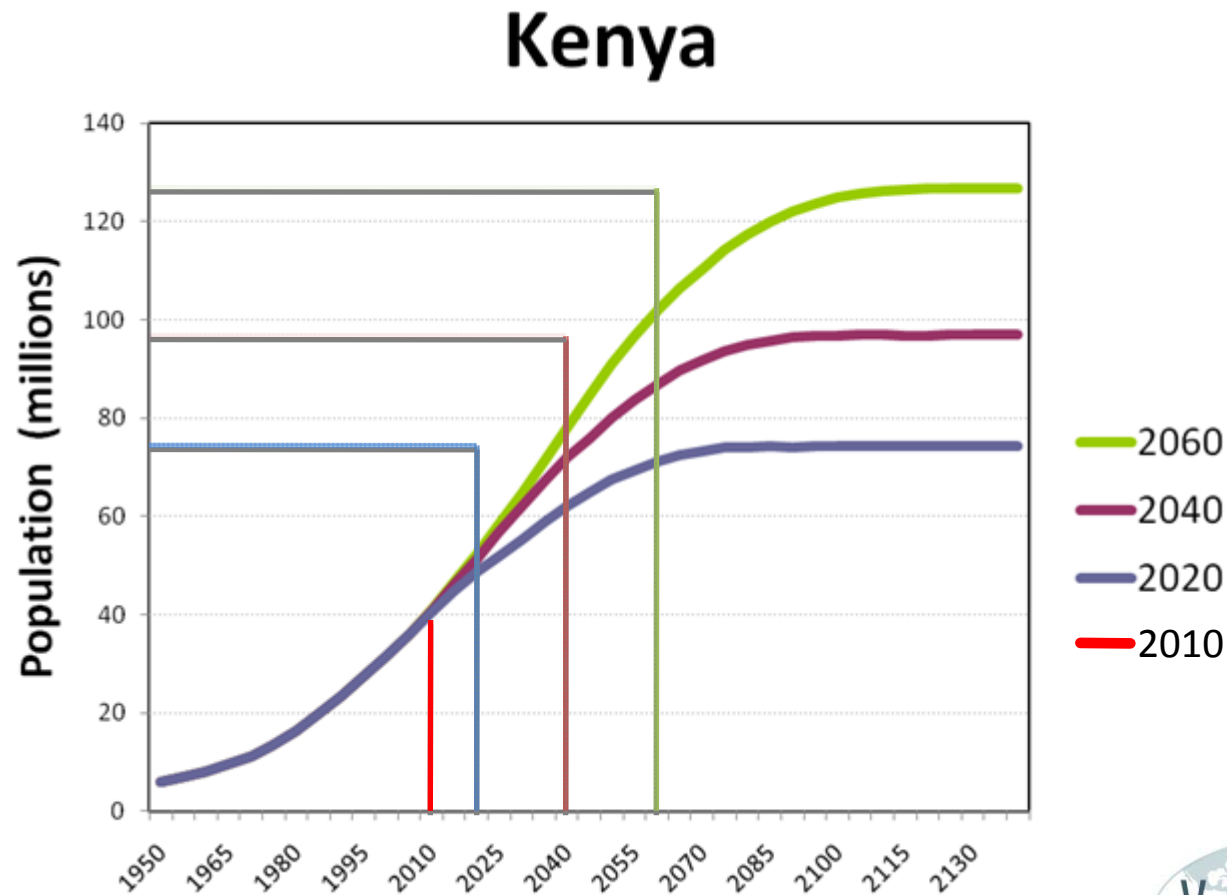
- “The population explosion is over”

- Concerns about aging
- Right wing opposition – especially in the US and especially about abortion
- Women’s groups at Cairo in 1994 framed “population” as politically incorrect

The year in which a country reaches replacement level fertility has a major impact on its ultimate population size.

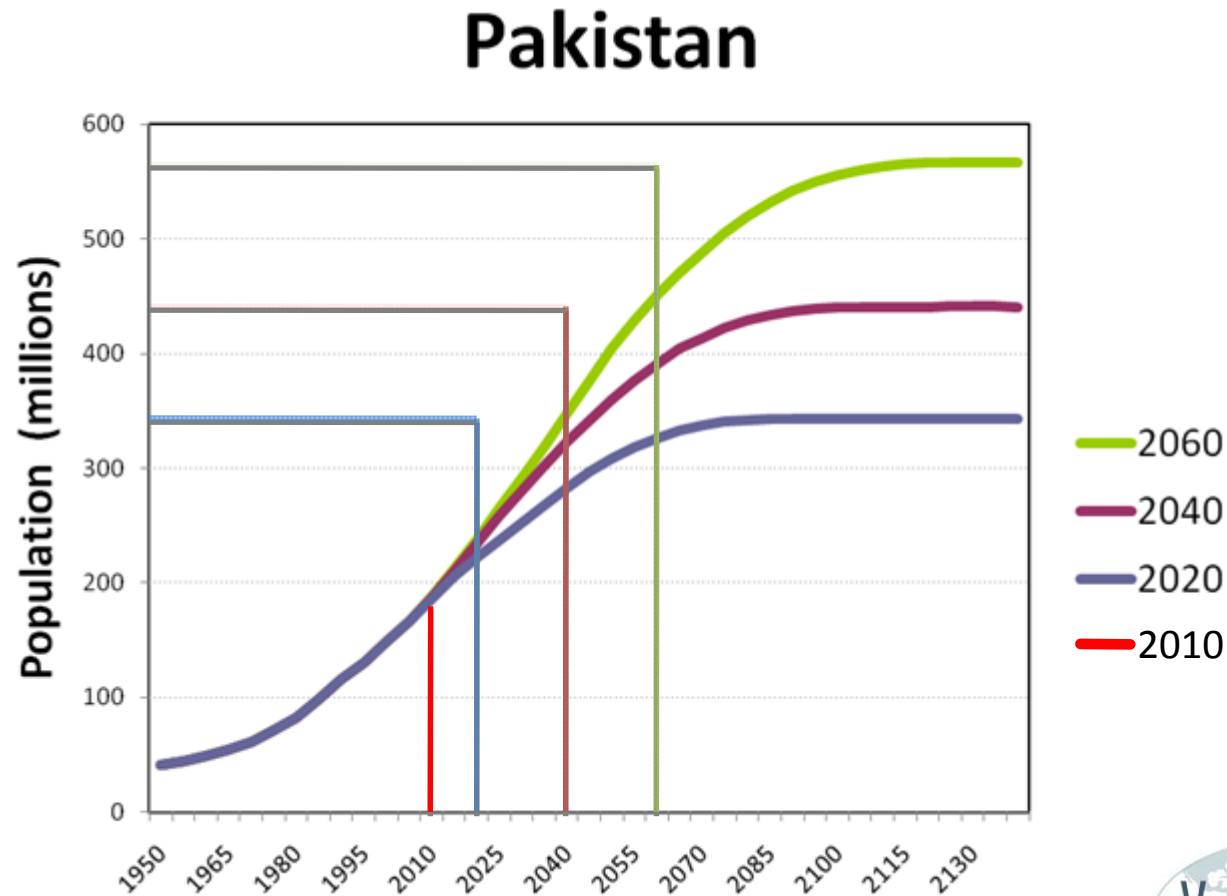


Total fertility rate: **4.6 (2010)**

Unmet need for family planning: **24% (2008)**



The year in which a country reaches replacement level fertility has a major impact on its ultimate population size.



Total fertility rate: **4.0 (2010)**

Unmet need for family planning: **33% (2008)**
