







# Droughts in Yunnan Since 1999



# Zinc Mining Case

• A case originated from a mass casualty incident 3 years ago in Shangpu village of Fuyuan county.

The nature of the incident—illegal or self-help



In Jan 6,2012, Staff attorney Mr. YANG minkua filed a **OGI request** and a request for administrative enforcement to EPB of Qujing city.

The request was declined for Yang was considered to be an irrelevant party. Then Attorney YANG filed a request for administrative reconsideration to EPB of Yunnan province in Jan 22

EPB of Yunnan province accepted the case, organized a pre- hearing and a follow-up meeting, and finally suggested the applicant to file a joint OGI and enforcement request

Yang withdrew the application and is working on a new joint request.
