What Was **New** About the PHE Alliance?

- An **integrated** strategy
- Resources to carry out **baseline & endline surveys**
- Ability to **pilot new indicators based on theory** of PHE linkages in conservation



Overarching **Lessons Learned**

More evidence that PHE:

- **Increases family planning use** in remote places
- **Improves conservation buy-in** among communities, and **basic health is vital**
- **Empowers women**, advances conservation



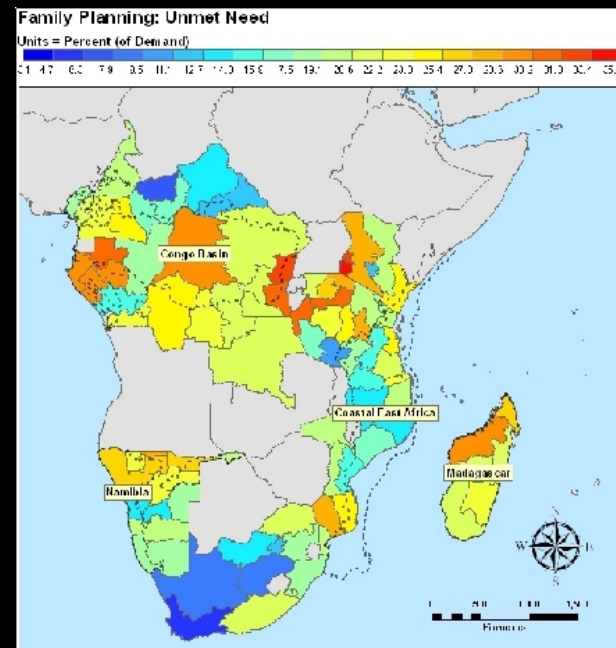
Expand

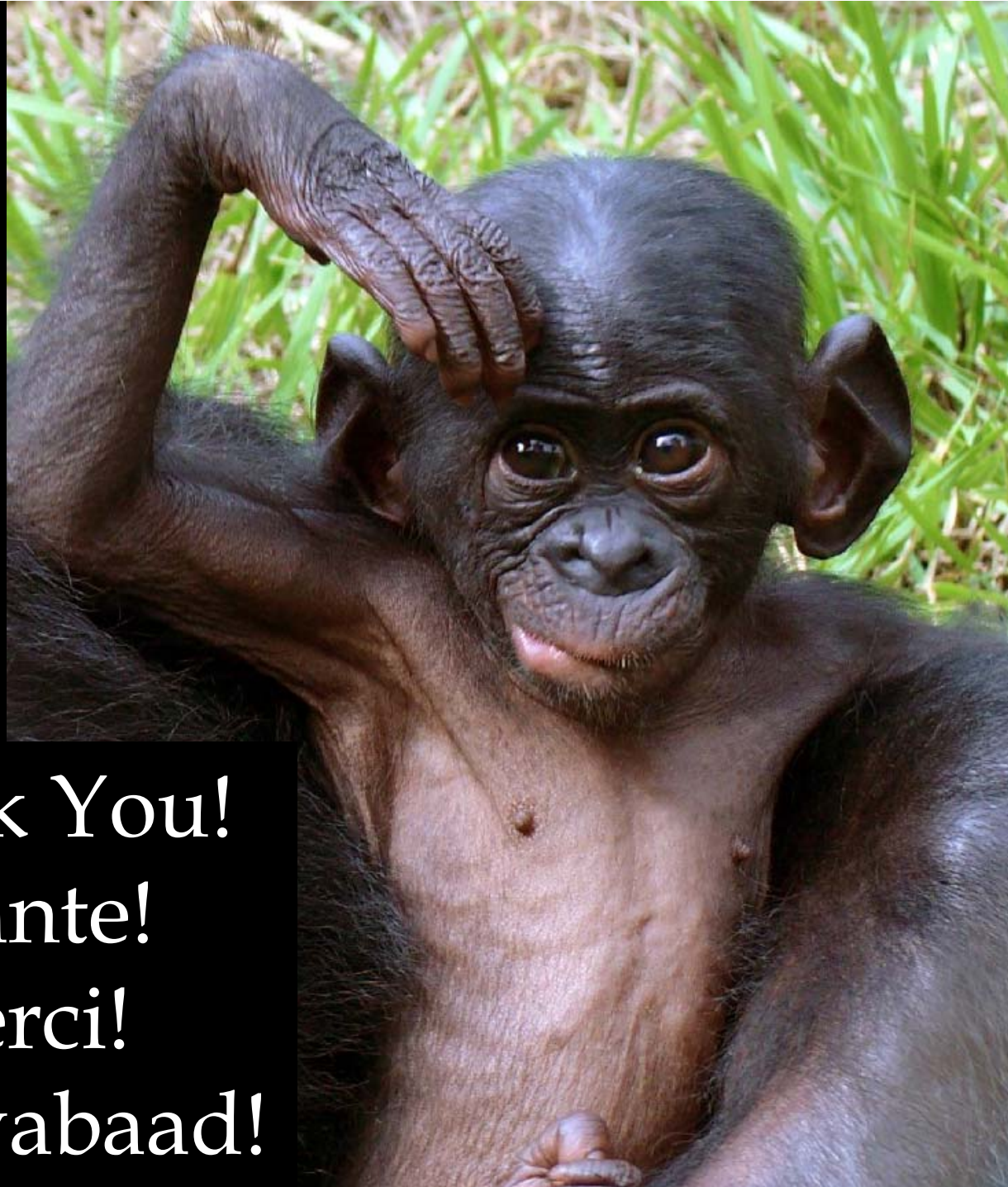




Empower Women
