






Corporate Partnership Model







Global Aquaculture Alliance / ACC	Global	Shrimp: tilapia, catfish, basa, salmon coming	110+ operations certified
GLOBALGAP	Global	Salmon: shrimp, tilapia, pangasius coming	60+ operations certified
Friend of the Sea	Global	Salmon, turbot, halibut, etc.	Multiple operations certified
ISO	Global	General standards	Standards being developed
Marine Stewardship Council	Global	No farmed fish	No standards for farmed fish
