

## THE WOODROW WILSON CENTER AT THE RONALD REAGAN BUILDING



**By Metro, at Federal Triangle Station:** Go to the top of the escalator at street level, cross Woodrow Wilson Plaza. Enter the Center's Lobby at the left (southeast) corner of the Ronald Reagan Building.

From Pennsylvania Avenue at 13th Street: Walk down Woodrow Wilson Plaza, the northsouth extension of 13th Street beside the Ronald Reagan Building. Enter the Center's lobby at the far end of the plaza—the southeast corner of the building.

**From 14th Street:** Go through the Ronald Reagan Building along the right (south) side of the atrium and continue past it. At the hall's end, turn left and enter the Woodrow Wilson Memorial. Go through the Memorial. At its far end, turn right into the Center's lobby.

**Public parking** in the Ronald Reagan Building is on Pennsylvania Avenue at 13 1/2 Street.
