



















Canadian Foreign Minister Lawrence Cannon, May 12, 2010, Speech at the 40th annual Washington Conference on the Americas

- "I was struck, recently, by the fact that Russia and Norway resolved a long-standing dispute in the Arctic. I believe there is no reason then why Canada and the United States cannot resolve ongoing disputes, as economic partners and best friends, sharing the longest border in the world. While the extent to which there may be overlaps with U.S. extended continental shelf in Beaufort is not yet known, I believe that should not keep our two nations from resolving that dispute and moving forward with current issues."
