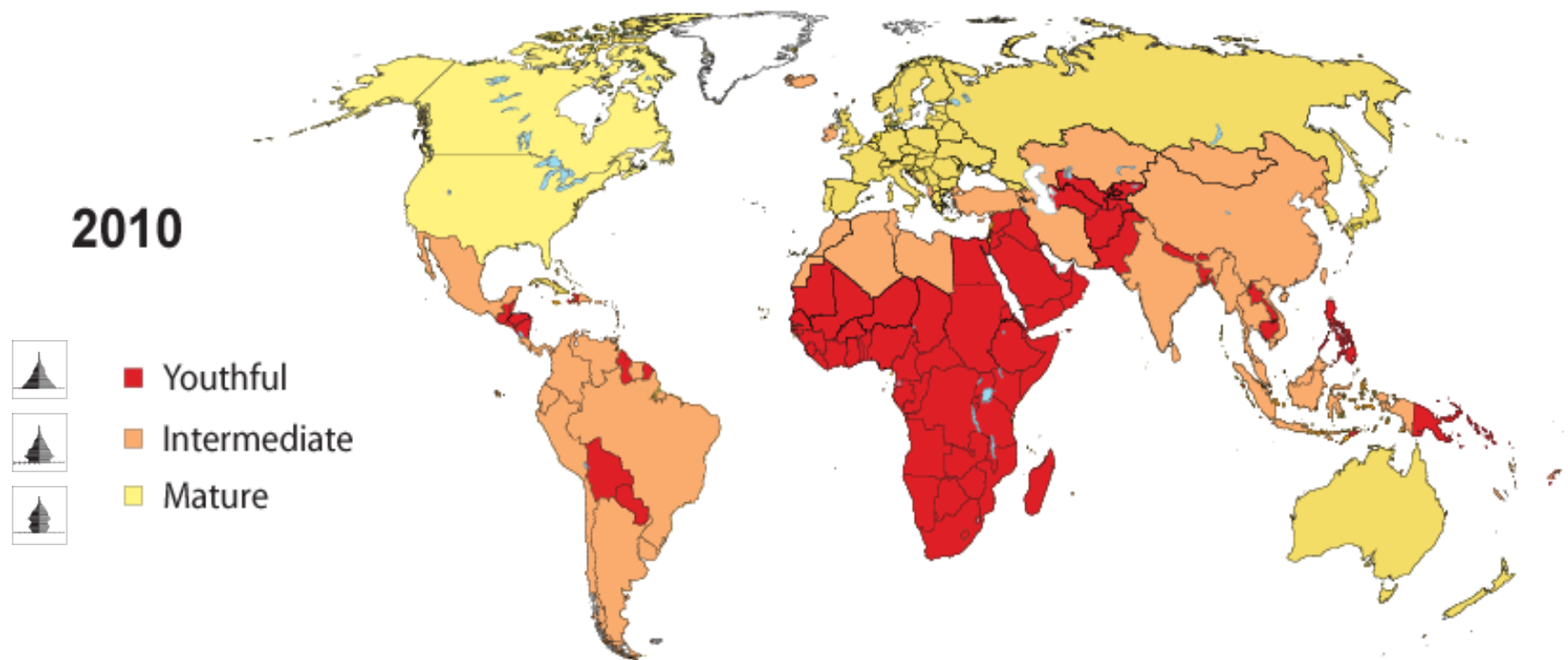

Age Structure and Trends in State Behavior (propensities)

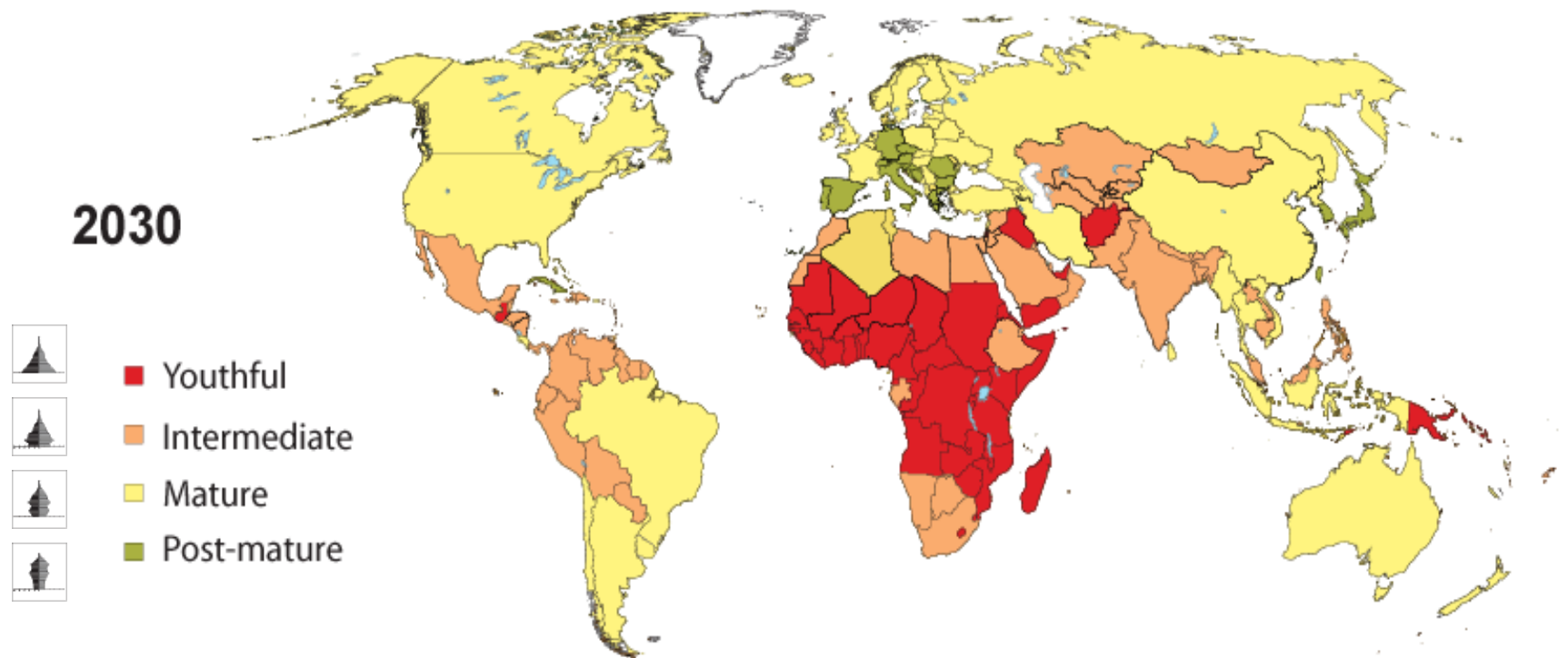


Age structures: 2010
