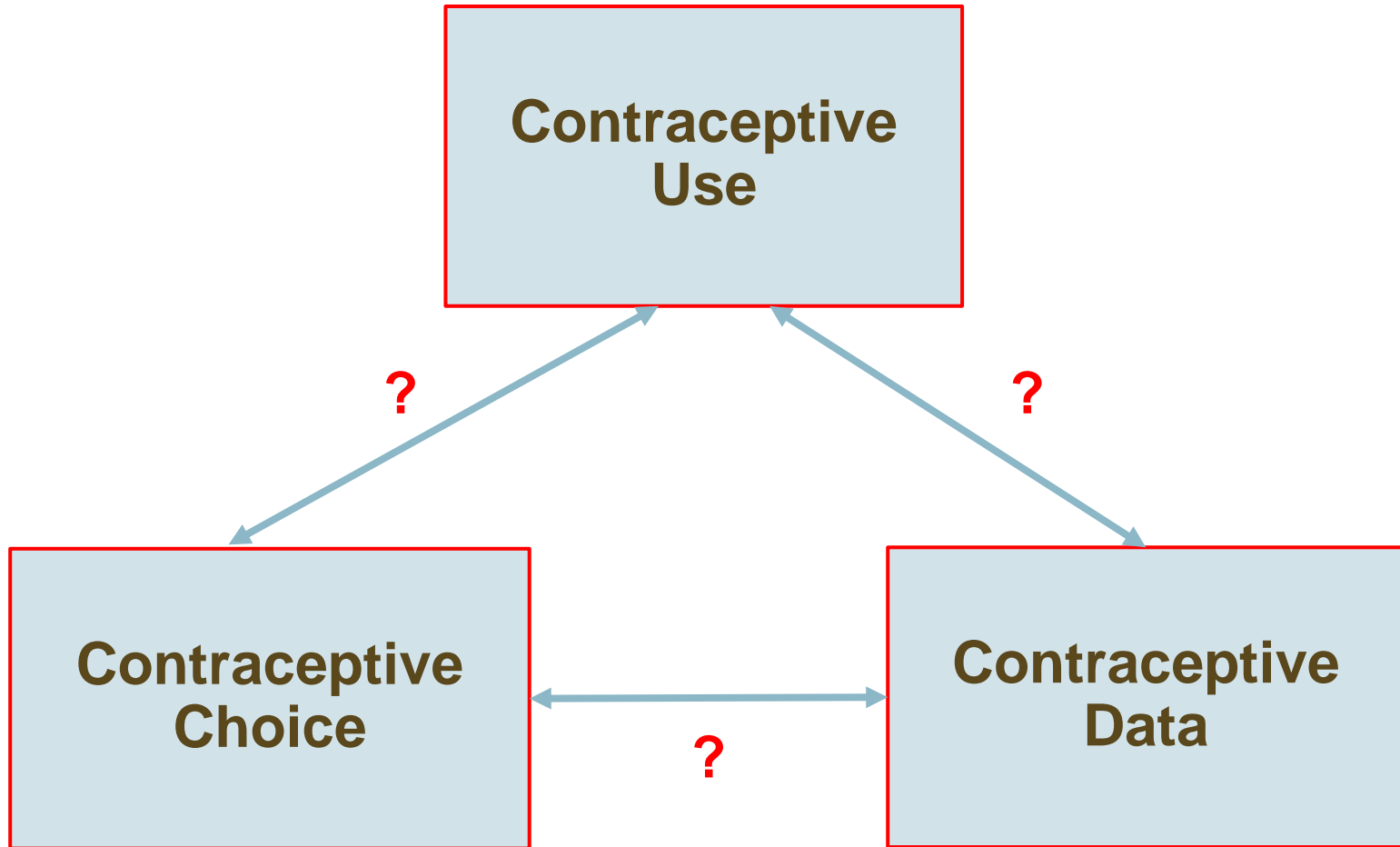

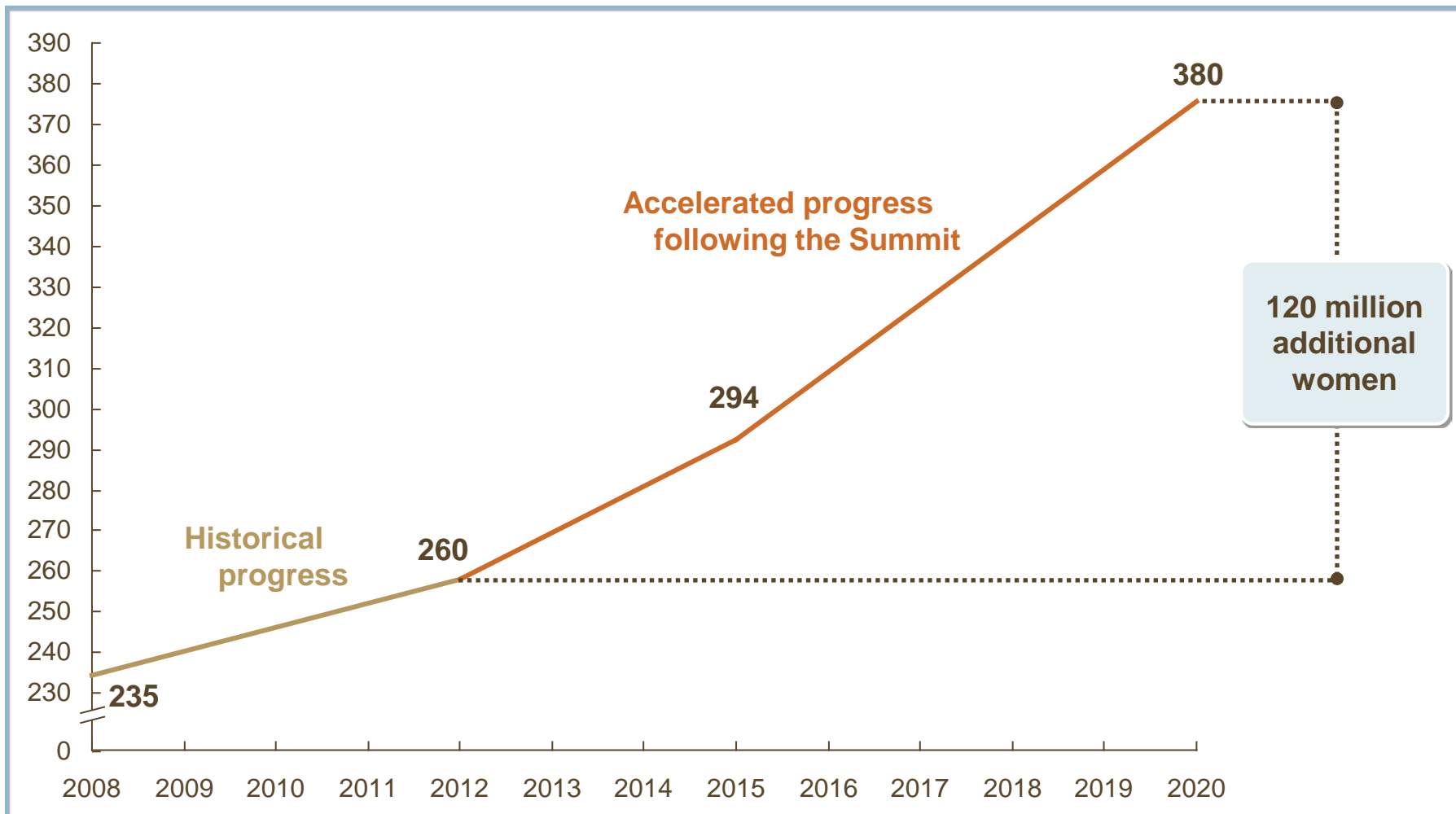
Contraceptive Use

The London FP Summit Monitoring Tasks are anchored by an overarching quantitative goal.

The London Family Planning Summit Goal of 120 Million “Additional Women” using Modern Methods of Contraception

Estimated progress to 2015 and 2020, 69 countries \$2,500 GNI per capita or less

MM women using modern contraception

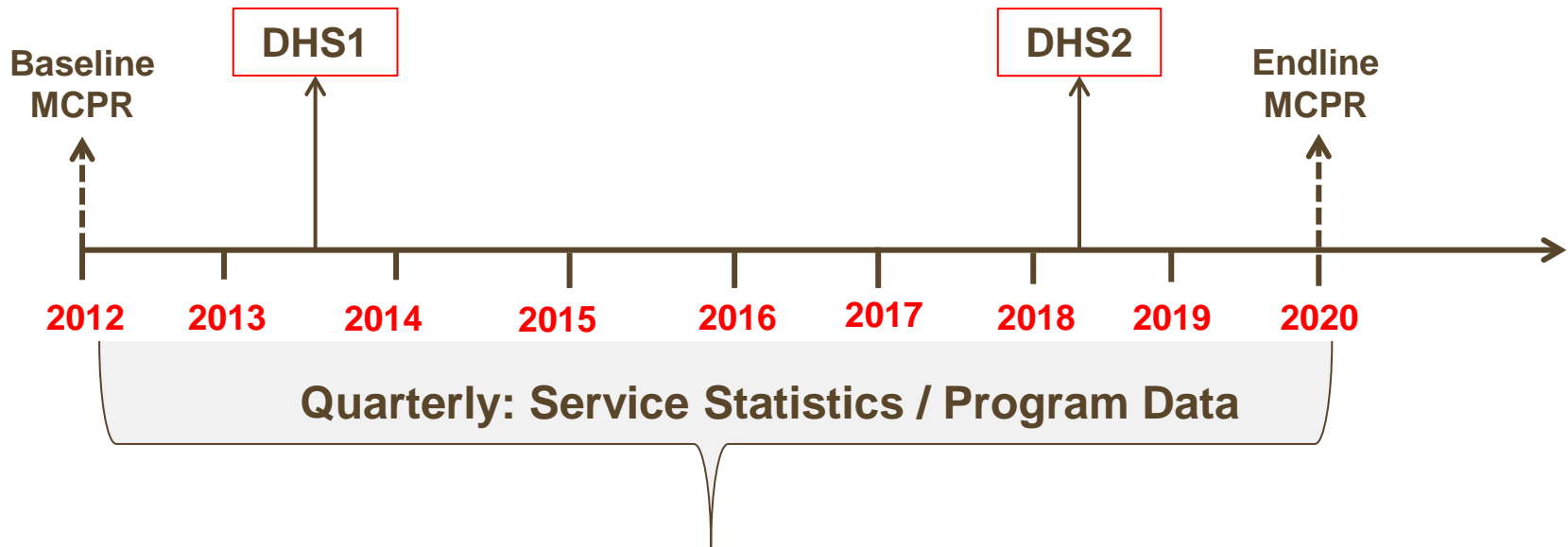

The Quality of Care Framework

“the way individuals and clients are treated by the system providing services” (Bruce 1990; Jain 1989).

- 1. Choice of contraceptive methods.**
- 2. Information given to clients.**
- 3. Technical competence of providers.**
- 4. Respectful client-provider relationship.**
- 5. Service continuity and follow-up.**
- 6. Appropriate constellation of services.**

Guiding Principles of M&A Working Group:

- 1. Alignment with key global initiatives and systems, such as EWEC and MDG monitoring.**
- 2. Alignment with country reporting systems; country ownership.**
- 3. Measurement and indicators reflect core values: rights, choice, voluntary family planning, quality of care, data transparency.**
- 4. Creative, innovative approaches to data availability, quality, and use.**
- 5. Broad-based participation of non-state actors and civil society, including capacity building.**
