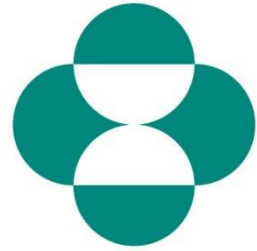

Mifeprex (RU-486)

- Mifeprex (RU-486) is a hormone-releasing birth control device for use by women to prevent pregnancy.
- You can use a single Mifeprex (RU-486) pill for up to three years.
- It is a flexible plastic rod about the size of a matchstick that contains a progestin hormone called etonogestrel.

How does it work?

- The progestin hormone in Mifeprex (RU-486) prevents a fertilized egg from growing.
- It is inserted into the wall of the inner part of your uterus.
- The hormone prevents you from getting pregnant.
- Mifeprex (RU-486) does not protect against sexually transmitted diseases including HIV/AIDS.
- The implant must be removed after three years.
- It is a reversible method for birth control. It does not affect your fertility.
- You can get pregnant again after you remove the implant.

Mifeprex (RU-486) prevents pregnancy in several ways:

- It stops the ovulation of an egg from the ovary.
- It thins the lining of the uterus so that any eggs that are released cannot reach the egg.

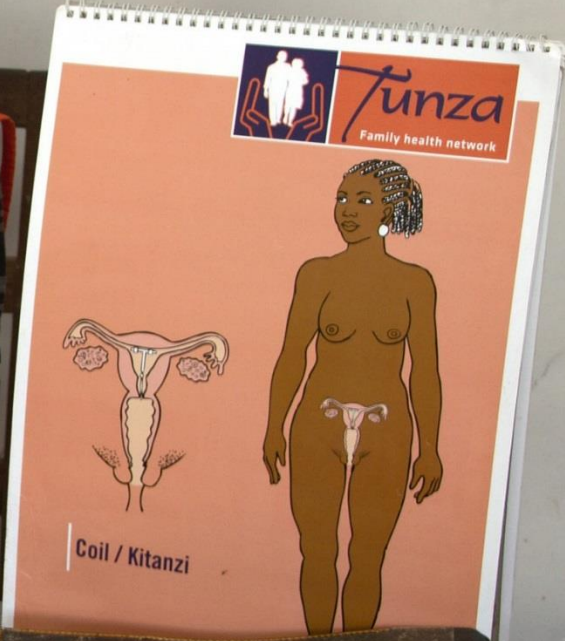
