Selecting Guatemala's Next Attorney General



In mid-May 2018, the President of Guatemala will select and appoint the new Attorney General (Fiscal General) from the Nominating Commission's list of finalists to lead the country's Office of the Public Ministry (Ministerio Público) for the next four years. The selection of the next Attorney General is a priority for Guatemalans and the international community since he or she is essential to eradicating corruption and impunity in Guatemala. Current Attorney General Thelma Aldana's term in office will end May 17, 2018; she has played a leading role in prosecuting corruption-related cases. The hope is that her successor will continue to help reduce crime and strengthen Guatemala's justice system.
