





#### **SYRIAN CONTEXT: HUMANITARIAN NEED**

- More than 7 years of conflict
- Over half the population has been displaced and over 17 million are in need of humanitarian assistance
- Violations of international humanitarian and human rights law occur.
- UN OCHA: "In the absence of a political solution to the conflict, intense and widespread hostilities are likely to persist."



Pregnancies that will end in miscarriage or unsafe abortion in the next 3 months	14,000	6,500









Figure 4. Was the examination conducted in a room where other people were present or could hear your conversation?






Figure 6. Did the health care worker treat you politely and with respect?







99% of FP clients reported they were "very satisfied" or "somewhat satisfied" with the services received.


