Anti-Corruption Commission

- Participatory process
- Comprehensive and very ambitious
- Deterrence, prevention, and education
- 5 areas: (1) Preventing corruption; (2) Regulating conflicts of interest; (3) Financing politics; (4) Market confidence; and (5) Ethics and citizens rights

Challenges

- Trust
- Comprehensive reform
- Implementation and enforcement: Resources, build human capital, ensure the effective investigation and prosecution of corruption.
- Effective complaint system and effective protection to whistleblowers (Coordination)
- Public financing to political parties (entrants vs. incumbents; political parties become disconnected from society)
