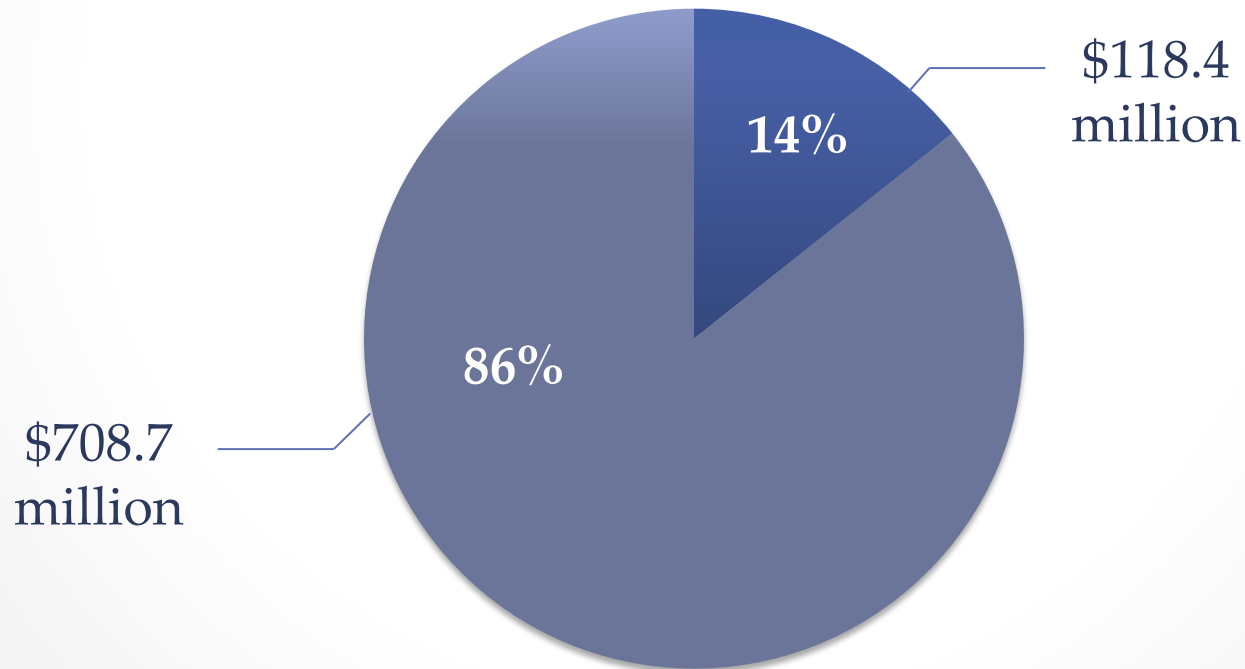

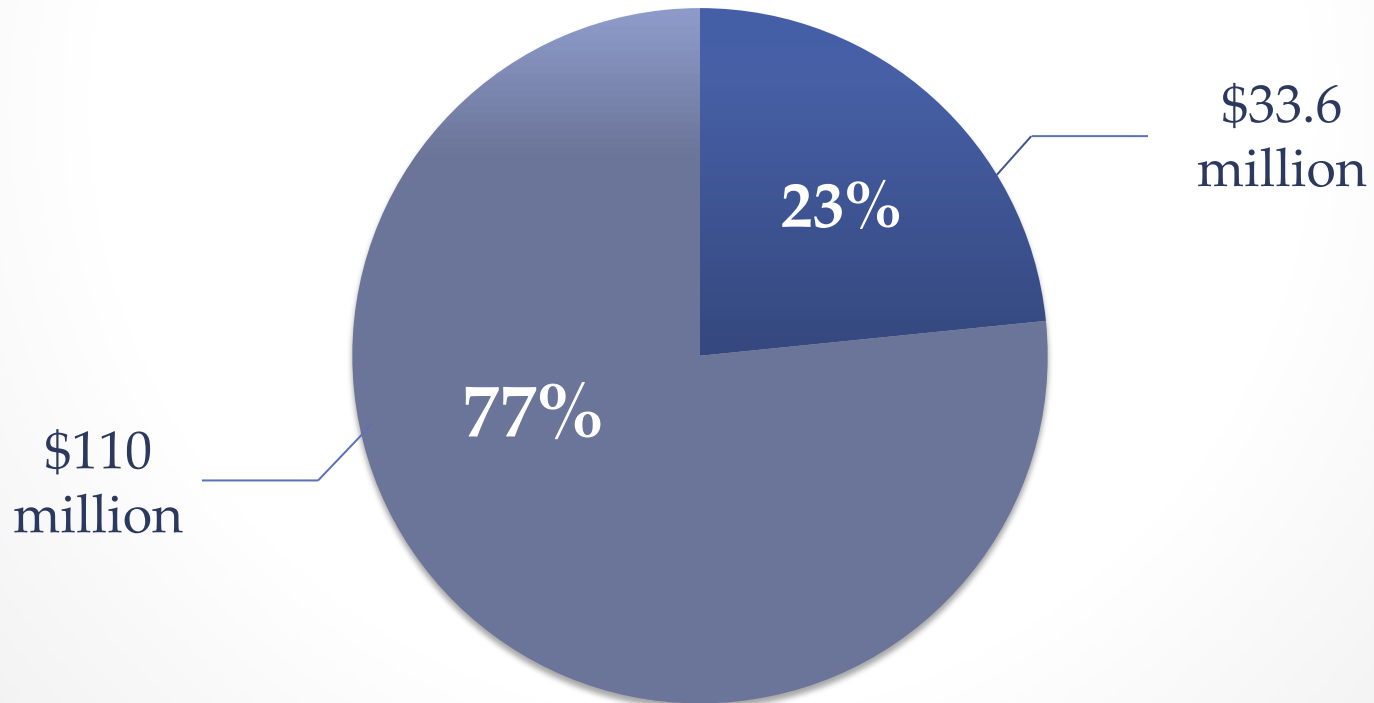

**\$ 143.6 million**

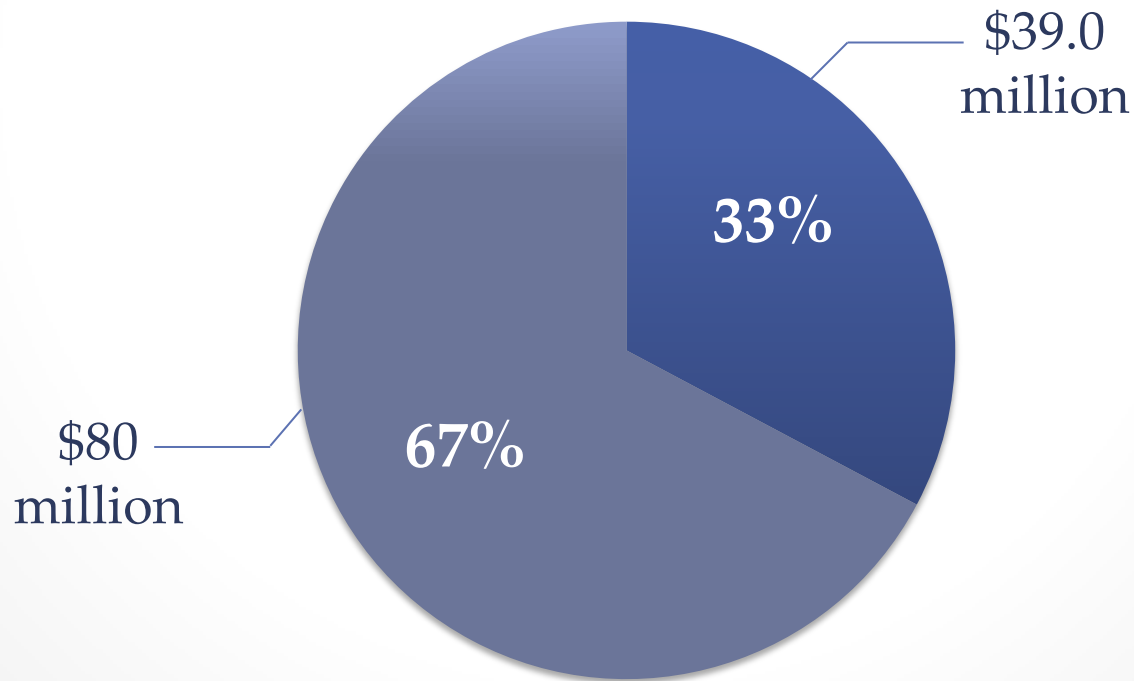

# FY 2016 Total Funding Requested

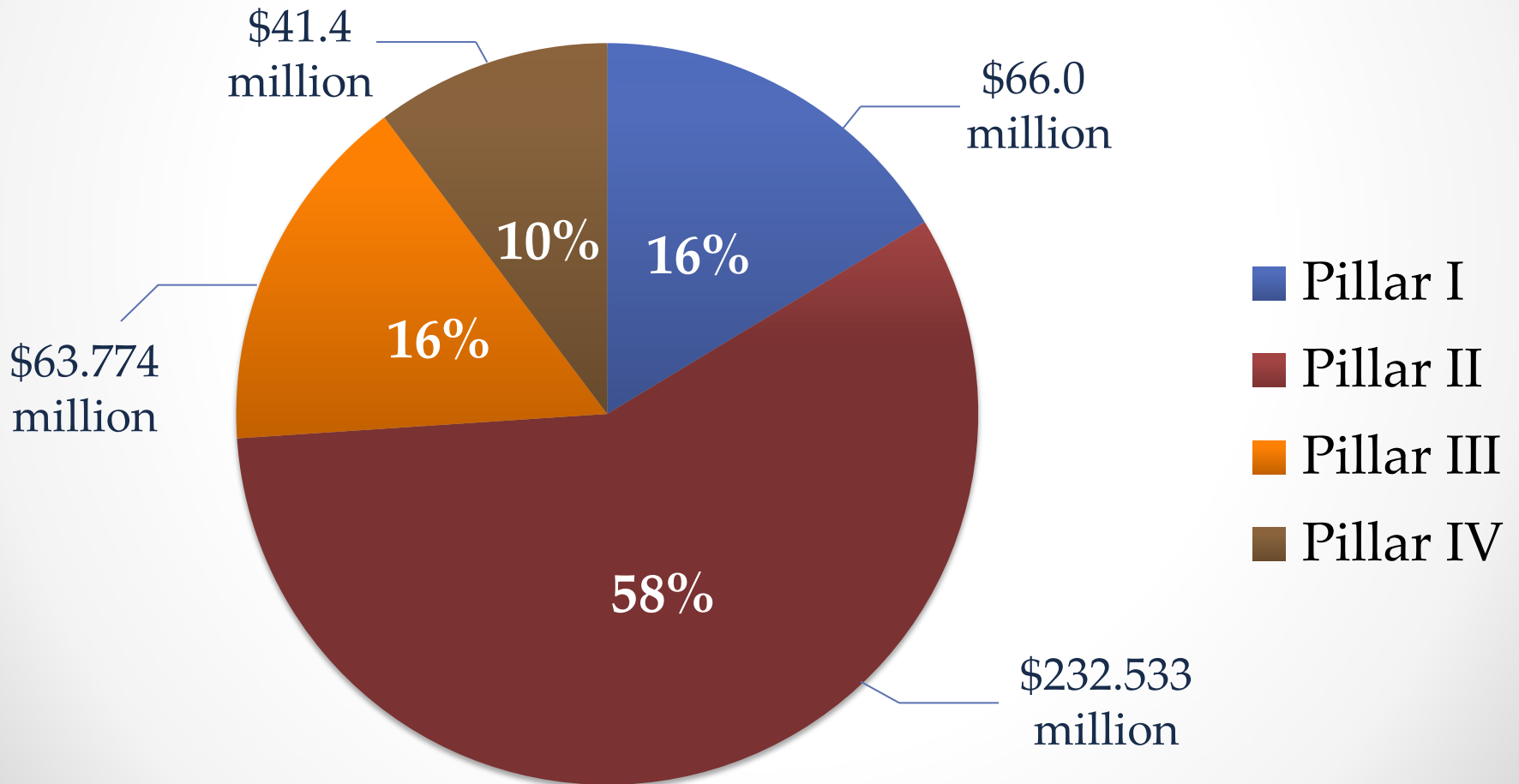
