misinformation is false information without malign intent. **propaganda** is one nation, state, or government trying to push its worldview onto other nations.

Combatting Disinformation

- 1 There should be more transparency around advertising, and the management of pages and groups on social media platforms
- 2 The United States should invest in the sustainability of local and independent media outlets
- 3 We need to equip citizens to be able to navigate the information environment they face today through nonpartisan civics and media literacy

Media Literacy is the knowledge of all forms of communications with the ability to **ACCESS, ANALYZE, and EVALUATE**



Implementing Regulations

- 1 There should be regulations to require **social media** platforms to undergo independent audits of their algorithms.
- 2 Regulations should be implemented to **disincentivize** political campaigns to participate in disinformation.


